Our Events



We design events for our charity partners that are **unique** and that reflect their **personality**. Some of our events include:

- **Trek26:** a Series of 13 mile and 26 mile treks for the Alzheimer's Society across iconic locations in the UK
- **The Muddy Dog Challenge Series:** the UK's first obstacle race for dogs and their owners on behalf of Battersea Dogs & Cats Home taking place across the UK.
- **Run The River:** a 5km and 10km timed run along the River Thames in Central London supporting Teach First
- **Trek24:** a series of 24 mile and 24km treks based in East Anglia on behalf of East Anglian Air Ambulance.
- **Only the Brave:** a 6mile and 10mile challenge muddy obstacle course on behalf of East Anglian Air Ambulance taking place on the Norfolk/Suffolk boarder.

The Role: Event Operations

The Operations Team will be responsible for the set-up and breakdown of the obstacle course or other event and event village in the days leading up to and following event days. Typical working times will be:

- Set up days: 08:00 – 17:00
- Event Day: 06:00 – 19:00
- De-rig day: 08:00 – 12:00

On event day, the Operations Team will also be responsible for area management out on the course, including repairing obstacles where necessary, managing and looking after volunteers and coordinating with the Course Director and medical staff.

- The role holder must be comfortable working both **independently** and as part of a **larger team** at different stages

We choose our team based on shared values, personality and passion rather than just experience. So please consider applying even if you don't feel you have all the skills required at this stage as we are happy to support and teach you!

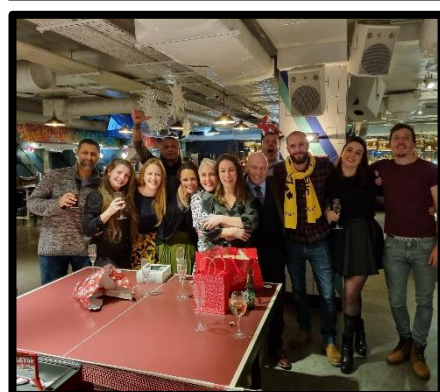
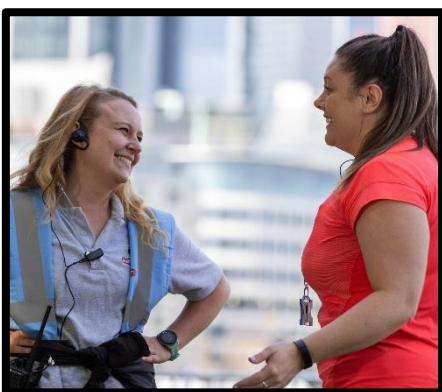
